CAMPGROUND POLICY AND REGULATIONS

- 1 REGISTRATION** ♦ Upon arrival guests must present themselves at the reception to register their documents. Therefore we ask you kindly to park your vehicle outside the campground.
- 2 GUESTS** ♦ Daytime visitors are asked to register at the reception and pay the visitor's fee before entering the campsite.
- 3 MOTOR VEHICLES** ♦ Cars and other vehicles must be parked outside the campground. Guests are requested to enter on foot. Parking at individual campsites must be authorized by the management and requires an extra charge. Loading and unloading luggage or hitching and unhitching caravans is only allowed between the hours of 7:30am and 11pm.
- 4 RESPECT FOR OTHER GUESTS** ♦ Apart from events organized by the management, all guests are asked to avoid disturbing the peace of others. In particular, between the hours of 11pm to 7am, nighttime peace and quiet shall be preserved.
- 5 MINORS** ♦ Children must always be accompanied by their legal guardians. The guardians are directly responsible for their behavior.
- 6 DEPARTURE** ♦ On the day of departure, the tents, caravan sites and apartments must be vacated by 11am.
- 7 PETS** ♦ Pets must be kept on a short leash in all areas of the campsite. Pets must be "walked" outside the campground for all their physiological needs ("solids and liquids"). Furthermore, pets are strictly forbidden to enter the buildings such as bar-restaurant, mini-market, reception, apartment or shower and toilet facilities. For pet owners, the "Dog Rules" apply in addition.
- 8 FIRE/BARBECUE** ♦ It is strictly forbidden to make camp-or barbecue-fire inside the camping area. Grilling with charcoal is only allowed at the designated barbecue-places (reservation required).
- 9 SMOKING** ♦ Smoking and vaping (e-cigarette) is prohibited in all enclosed areas (such as the bar, restaurant, reception, mini-market, apartment, bathrooms)
- 10 WASTE** ♦ Guests are requested to dispose their sorted garbage in the trash cans provided. It is forbidden to bury waste, to damage vegetation or to pollute water.
- 11 LAST BUT NOT LEAST** ♦ The instructions of the camping staff must be followed without exception.
